Beginners	Level		Really Learn English Products for This Level
Low	1	<b>At the beginning of this level:</b> The students might know a few basic English words, such as "hi," "thank you," and "telephone." They do not know the alphabet and cannot read. No understanding of correct sentence structure. Complete Novice.	
		<b>Topics covered in this level:</b> Basic English vocabulary, mainly using games and different activities	
		<b>End product of this level:</b> The students know some basic vocabulary, such as the pronouns (such as <i>I, you, she</i> ), some simple common nouns (such as <i>dog, car, box</i> ) and verbs (such as <i>go, sit, say</i> ). They know the numbers to 10.	
		<b>Topics covered in this level:</b> The letters of the alphabet, the numbers 0 to 20.	
Middle	2	<b>End product of this level:</b> The students have basic understanding of the alphabet and some practice. They know the basic sounds of letters (but not all possible combinations, such as <i>ck, oo, th</i> , silent <i>e</i> ). They know the numbers 0 to 20.	
		<b>Topics covered in this level:</b> Very simple reading with many illustrations ("phonetic" words only), basic punctuation marks, the numbers 0 to 100.	
High	3	<b>End product of this level:</b> The students know the alphabet well enough to read phonetic words (words that are pronounced simply as they are spelled, without considering additional rules. For example: <i>boy, big, yes, stand, get, sister</i> ) They know basic punctuation signs: period, comma, question mark, and exclamation point. They know the numbers to 100.	• <a href="#">English Short Stories for Complete Beginners</a>
		<b>Topics covered in this level:</b> Very simple reading with many illustrations ("phonetic" words only), basic punctuation marks, the numbers 0 to 100.

Low	4	<b>Topics covered in this level:</b>	
		All major reading rules, all important punctuation signs, capitalization.	
		<b>End product of this level:</b>	
		The students know the alphabet and additional spelling rules, well enough to read more advanced words (such as <i>table, ball, receive, ice, night, black</i> ). They know all important punctuation signs: period, comma, question mark, exclamation point, colon, semicolon, hyphen, dashes. They know how to use capital letters. They know the basics of correct pronunciation.	
Middle	5	<b>Topics covered in this level:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">English Plural Nouns, a Step-by-Step Guide</a></li> </ul>
		Common vocabulary, simple reading practice with illustrations, the basic structure of sentences in English (focus on the simple present tense), plural forms, communication activities in English, how to use a dictionary.	
		<b>End product of this level:</b>	
		The students know the alphabet and its spelling rules very well and can easily read. They understand the basic structure of sentences in English (subject + verb, adjectives come before the noun they describe, using a/an/the and am/is/are, there is/there are). They know how to make nouns plural (regular and common irregular nouns). They have a good foundation of common vocabulary. They can communicate in a very basic way, mainly in the simple present tense. They can successfully use a dictionary.	
High	6	<b>Topics covered in this level:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">Simple Present Stories and Exercises</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">Learning English and Your Human Rights</a></li> </ul>
		The simple present tense, comparatives and superlatives, adverbs, countable and uncountable nouns, possessive forms, additional vocabulary.	
		<b>End product of this level:</b>	
		The students have understanding of basic grammar topics such as: The simple present tense, comparatives and superlatives, adverbs, countable and uncountable nouns, possessive forms and wider vocabulary. They can communicate in a basic way, mainly in the simple present tense.
