**A. Answer the following questions. Use the Present Progressive tense.**

1. Where are Mike and Tina sitting on Monday morning? What are they doing?

Mike and Tina are sitting at the table. They are eating breakfast.

2. Where is Tina sitting now? What is Tina eating?

Tina is sitting across from Mike. She is eating a pastry.

3. Where are Mike and Tina going after breakfast? How are they getting there?

After breakfast, Mike and Tina are going to work. They are riding the bus.
