A. Answer the following questions. Use the Simple Future tense.

1. Who is going to get married at 4 o'clock? Who will be there?

At 4 o'clock, Megan Smith and Mark Jones are going to get married.

Everyone will be there.

2. Who will give a speech? Who will dance?

The best man will give a speech. Everyone will dance.

3. Where are Megan and Mark going the day after their wedding? How long are they going to stay there?

The day after the wedding, Megan and Mark are going to Hawaii for their honeymoon. They are going to stay there for 7 days.

B. Rewrite the following sentences as negative sentences, yes/no questions, WH-questions (using the underlined word or phrase) and tag questions.

1. There is going to be a wedding today.

Negative: There is not going to be a wedding today.

Yes/No Question: Is there going to be a wedding today?

WH-Question: When is there going to be a wedding?

Tag Question: There is going to be a wedding today, isn't there?

2. Everyone will dance.

Negative: Everyone will not dance.

Yes/No Question: Will everyone dance?

WH-Question: What will everyone do?

Tag Question: Everyone will dance, won't they?

3. They will have a good time in Hawaii.

Negative: They will not have a good time in Hawaii.

Yes/No Question: Will they have a good time in Hawaii?

WH-Question: Who will have a good time in Hawaii?

Tag Question: They will have a good time in Hawaii, won't they?

C. Rewrite the story using contractions.
